A native of Nelson County, Virginia, Tom McKenzie received a Bachelor of Music Education from James Madison University in 1982, where he was a student of George West. After college, he was accepted into the United States Air Force Band, where he served assignments at Barksdale Air Force Base, Louisiana, and Ramstein Air Base, Germany.

Since leaving the Air Force, he has played in a wide variety of musical groups, including the Shenandoah Valley Bach Festival Orchestra, the Lynchburg Symphony Orchestra, the University Shenandoah Symphony Orchestra (Lexington, VA), and the Massanutten Brass Band. He has played in chamber groups such as the Madison Brass Quintet at James Madison University, and the Brass 5 Quintet from Roanoke, and performed with the Skyline Brass Ensemble at the International Trombone Workshop. He is often called to play in jazz groups, in the orchestra for visiting shows throughout the region, and a variety of other groups.

Currently he lives in Harrisonburg, Virginia, where he is a member of the Mr. Jefferson's Bones trombone quartet, the music director of Just Jazzin', a Valley-based community big band, and a member of Big Ray and the Kool Kats, a popular wedding and convention band out of Charlottesville. In addition to his musical endeavors, he is a very active freelance computer programmer and is training to run his first half-marathon in November.
